We have identified areas where students need the most help in successfully completing the course.

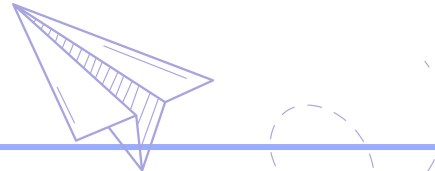
In person and live online classes mean that students can ask questions in real time and participate in learning from not only the trainers but from each other.
